As the anticipation of an impending battle mounted, a sudden gust from above changed everything. Armed helicopters roared overhead before setting down amidst the onlookers.


Stepping out of the helicopters were several sharply dressed men. Leading the group was a familiar face to Liam. It was the deputy minister of Ministry of Defense.
