Judging from the way Jaxson was acting, it was obvious that Ronald was from a super-rich family.

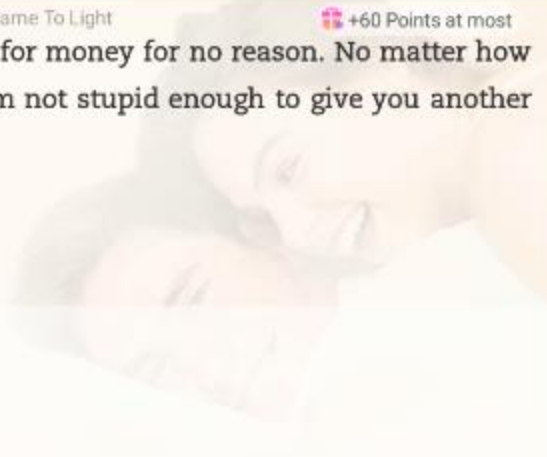
