Even though both Elizabeth and Tasha seemed shocked, Mandy decided not to spill the details just yet. Exposing the woman's lies took precedence.

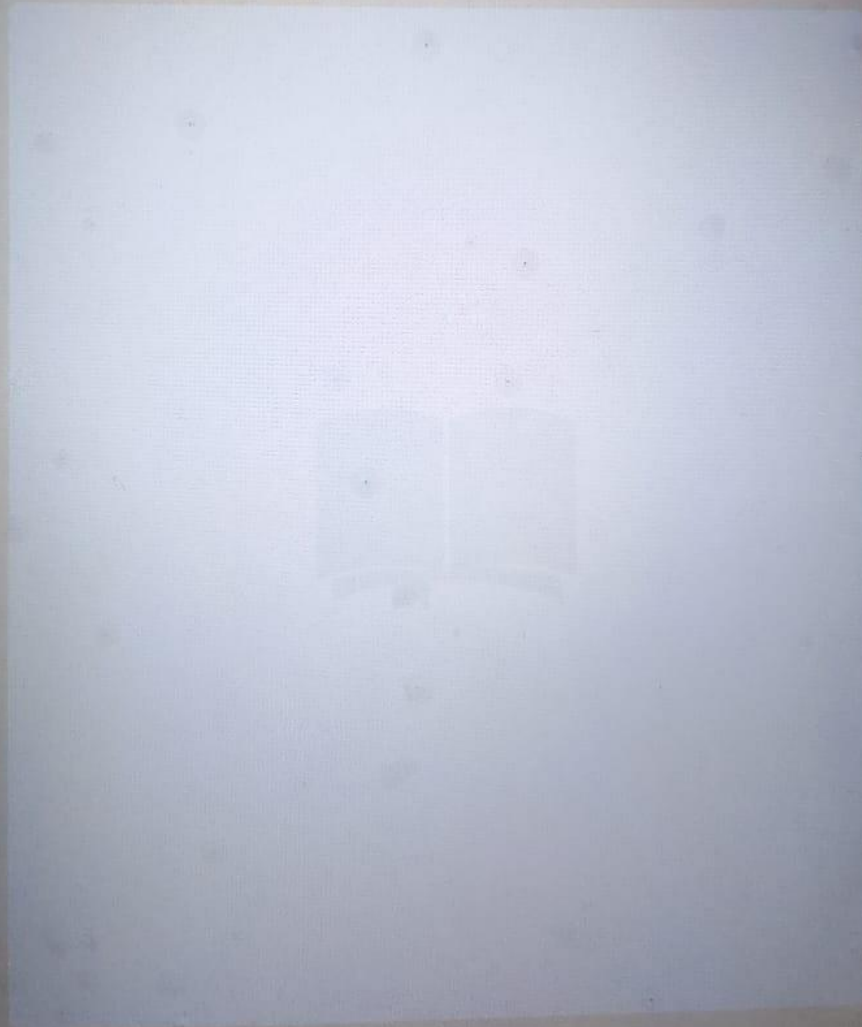
